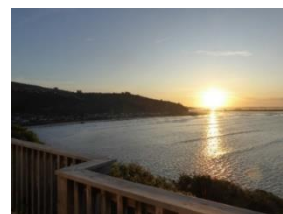

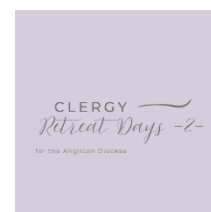

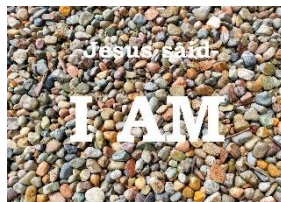

Praying with Evelyn Underhill – A 7-day silent directed retreat

Evelyn Underhill's belief that all of life was sacred, was based on her understanding of the incarnation. Evelyn (1875- 1941) was born into a wealthy secular family but had several mystical experiences during her childhood. Her lifelong search for the meaning of these experiences was the driving force behind her research and writing on the Christian life. She was a prolific author and published over 30 books on spirituality. She was the first woman to deliver lectures to the clergy in the Church of England, to officially conduct spiritual retreats for the Church, to establish ecumenical links between churches, and one of the first woman theologians to lecture in English



colleges and universities. In this retreat we will use some of Evelyn's writings on Prayer to throw light on our own spiritual journeys. Daily individual spiritual direction will be available.

In this retreat, Eddie looks at the first week of the Spiritual Exercises as a medieval example of 'Shadow work', a confrontation with the unacknowledged dark side of our personality that we must come to terms with if we are to become the undivided people God is calling us to be. GETTING TO SISTER EVELEEN RETREAT HOUSE

Our Location:

Please be aware of our [access disclosure](#) - SERH is a very secluded retreat, which unfortunately means that there is limited vehicular access. Getting to SERH involves a ten minute uphill walk and then a short walk to the house either via a steep uneven zigzag path that is not wheelchair friendly or an almost level track from the top.



If you are able, we encourage the use of public transport, walking, or cycling as part of your journey to us, as a mindful way to begin this retreat day and to honour and protect our creation.

by public Transport:

The bus no. 3 goes (via Bus Exchange) to Sumner ([Timetable](#)), Bus Stop: Nayland St./near Head St..

Walking from there is about 20 min.

by bike:

The cycleways are very well built to Sumner, either on the road or via [Te Ara Ihutai-The Coastal pathway](#).

Bring your bike up the track and you can lock it at the fence.

by car:

There is not very much parking on Whitewash Head Road, and this usually taken by neighbours, so it is best to park down by the waterfront, on Heberden Avenue, or Scarborough Pool ([see map on website](#)) and walk up the hill. Even if there are parks on Whitewash we ask that you don't use them as there are already insufficient parks for residents. You're more than welcome to park temporarily to drop off your things, though. -

If you are dropped by car or if you have some difficulties with the hill, you could use the almost level pathway to Sister Eveleen House – ask for a more detailed map

Once you are at Whitewash Head Road

Walk up the road until the end of the stone wall, enter through our gate and follow the path

If you are dropped off rather than driving yourself

There is no parking on the road up to Sister Eveleen, so all cars need to be left parked by the playground at the bottom of the hill for the week we are on retreat. Whitewash Head Road itself is narrow, but there is a turning and drop-off space at the top of the first leg of the hill where the road turns the corner.

An unmarked pedestrian entrance between houses number 16 & 18 leads onto an almost level walking track that takes you behind the row of houses to just past the rear entrance to Sister Eveleen Retreat House. Come down the steps and the path ends at the back door of the Retreat House.
